Amangani in Summer

Jackson Hole is located in the southern half of the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. This ecosystem is comprised of a huge expanse of mountains, meadows, sage flats, river bottoms, national forests, and wildlife refuges including both Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks. We are also located in the middle of the largest contiguous forest in the United States.

In the summer, warm days and cool nights can be expected. Mountain and valley hiking trails wind through a world dressed in wildflowers. Wildlife abounds, including bison, elk, mule deer, moose, pronghorn antelope, grizzly and black bears, coyotes, wolves, bald eagles, and more.

Within this rich and varied ecosystem, activities are limitless. We have compiled a series of excursions that will allow you to explore Jackson Hole and its magical environment. In addition to our Amangani Signature Tours, other excursions are offered in conjunction with the most professional and preferred outfitters in the area. Most of these activities are offered in group or private settings.

A trip to Amangani and Jackson Hole would not be complete without experiencing our Signature Tours.

At Amangani, we offer in-house guided wildlife safaris, tours of Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks, as well as butte-top hikes. Any of these activities would be the perfect start to an Amangani vacation, learning first-hand about the area while also becoming acclimated to our mountainous environment.

Enjoy a wildlife expedition through the pristine valley of Jackson Hole with an experienced guide who will introduce you to the fantastic array of wildlife in the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem. Your Concierge will be able to design your itinerary to fit your needs. While on your trip, be on the lookout for big game like moose, elk, bison, wolves, and bears. Also, keep an eye out for the 300 species of birds found in Jackson Hole, including bald eagles, mountain bluebirds, trumpeter swans, and sandhill cranes.

Statistically, Grand Teton National Park is our nation's number one National Park for wildlife observation and tours can be booked as a half-day or three-quarter day. A Yellowstone National Park tour constitutes a full-day tour and will be teeming with an abundance of wildlife and vast geological wonders.

Amangani Signature Hiking

Butte Top

Jackson serves as a great base for short excursions or all-day adventures to Grand Teton National park. Visit scenic Jenny Lake and Jackson Lake for amazing views and great hiking. Touring Yellowstone, the world's first national park, will require a full day. Sprawling across volcanic plateaus in the northwest corner of Wyoming, Yellowstone contains more than two million acres of crystalline lakes, thundering waterfalls, panoramic vistas, and steaming geysers including Old Faithful. We suggest getting an early morning start and touring the "Lower Loop" of the park.

Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks typically open in May and close early November. When exploring the parks, let our Concierge arrange an Amangani wildlife guide to accompany and enhance an already fantastic experience. An Amangani picnic breakfast or lunch can be arranged to bring with you. If you go on your own, be sure to take some snacks and water.

Via Ferrata is Jackson Hole Mountain Resort's newest outdoor adventure. The entire Via Ferrata is above 9,000'. This memorable experience takes you high above the valley floor, across suspended bridges and along granite walls all with a knowledgeable guide. An assisted climbing activity that is guided through the alpine terrain here at JHMR, Via Ferrata is perfect for families, groups or individuals. Half day and full day experiences are offered.

Grand Teton National Park is a world-renowned location for hiking. From the scenic and moderate hikes around Jenny, Leigh and Phelps Lakes to the more strenuous hikes into Cascade, Death and Granite Canyons, the Tetons offer a trail for any ability. While guided tours are not permitted in Grand Teton National Park, guided hikes into the National Forests that surround Jackson are available through a preferred vendor. The Bridger-Teton and Targhee National Forests provide an unforgettable backdrop for those who prefer longer hikes and require a guide.

Jackson Hole Golf And Tennis

At the foot of the breathtaking Teton Mountain Range is one of the country's most scenic and well-designed golf courses. Designed by internationally famous golf course designer Robert Trent Jones Jr., each hole has a spectacular view of the surrounding snow-capped peaks. The natural beauty of the terrain, which includes the Gros Ventre River winding along many of the holes, creates a unique and challenging course.

Non-member tee times are offered from 1:00PM – 3:00PM. Tee times can be reserved only through the Jackson Hole Golf and Tennis website.

The Snake River quietly threads its way through the natural landscape that lies beneath the majestic peaks of the Teton Mountain Range. This is a perfect way to take in the beauty and wonder of Jackson Hole at a leisurely pace. Relax and enjoy the chance to see bald eagles, pelicans, moose, deer, bison, beaver and more. This is a great activity for people of all ages and can be enjoyed privately or in groups. Another wonderful option is booking a private wooden boat tour; this trip allows guests to leave the main river and explore its many side channels that end at a Private Tipi Camp beside the Snake River - the perfect choice for those looking for a more intimate and romantic trip on the river.

Fly Fishing

Jackson Hole is home to some of the world's best trout fishing. The lakes and streams below the Tetons feature one of the few remaining populations of wild cutthroat trout as well as many other game fish. A professional guide can lead you to some of the most secluded fly-fishing spots on the Snake River, or one of the many other trophy fly-fishing spots in the valley. To maintain the balance in the ecosystem, all fishing tours are catch-and-release. A Wyoming Fishing License is required for 13 years and above.



Jenny Lake Ferry

Depart from the South end of Jenny Lake to enjoy a short ferry ride to the Hidden Falls boat dock. Hiking trails branch out into the Grand Teton National Park and beyond. It is easy to be captivated by the majestic views of the Teton Mountain Range and the quiet surroundings of the lake. A group or private afternoon cruise can also be arranged with a knowledgeable boat captain.

Kayaking And Canoeing

Paddling your own kayak or canoe across a glassy mountain lake can be one of the most rewarding methods of touring. Jackson Hole's lakes and streams are numerous and diverse for enthusiasts of all skill levels, whether you are out on your own having a lakeside picnic or arranged by a guided tour.

Floating In The Tetons By Hot Air Balloon

Hot air ballooning above the valley is an awe-inspiring beginning to the day. Upon launch, you will discover the wonders and serenity of a hot air balloon flight. Soaring over 1,000 feet above the valley floor in total silence, enjoy 360-degree views of the Grand Tetons, Snake River, and beautiful Jackson Hole from your group or private balloon basket. Ballooning is only offered in the early morning when winds are calm. Please expect an early start between 6:00AM and 7:00AM.

Tandem Paragliding

This experience is truly for the most adventurous of travelers. Ride the Bridger Gondola or the Big Red Tram at Teton Village and launch in a tandem paraglide with a certified pilot from the heights of the Jackson Hole Mountain Resort. Soar among the mountains like a bird in flight and gaze downward upon granite cliffs, meadows of wildflowers, evergreen forests and rushing streams.

Scenic Flight Over The Tetons

60 min Tour

This scenic ride in a Cessna Hawk XP or Quest Kodiak will take you over the Teton Mountain Range and the valley of Teton County, Idaho. Knowledgeable pilots will point out the Grand Teton Cathedral Group, Yellowstone National Park, Grand Targhee, Jackson Hole Aerial Tram, Table Mountain, Mount Moran, and up to seven mountain ranges if the conditions are right. This is the perfect way to view the splendor of our mountains and great for photographs.

Yellowstone Photo Flight By Helicopter

Experience an unforgettable aerial photo flight over the greater Yellowstone ecosystem in a luxurious private helicopter. There is no better way to appreciate the nearly 3,500 square-mile landscape of dramatic canyons, alpine rivers, lush forests, hot springs, and gushing geysers.

For a true taste of the West, test your skill with a variety of rifles, shotguns, pistols or even bow and arrow through personalized shooting instruction and firearms training in a fun, safe and educational environment. You may want to try your aim shooting at reactive style targets with western style pistols or learning long distance rifle marksmanship. Whether you are an experienced shooter or touching a firearm for the very first time, there are a variety of simulated scenarios to suit every age and interest.

Covered Wagon Cookout

Families of all ages can enjoy the ride into the mountains with a “Cowboys and Indians” reenactment and then settle in for a hearty home-cooked meal. The dinner show is rich with live folk music and old west humor.

The cookout is very popular, so kindly contact your Amangani Concierge for advanced reservations.

Jackson Hole Historical Society and Museum

For a glimpse into the past, the Jackson Hole Museum is not to be missed. Get a feel for what life was like for the first settlers to Jackson Hole and how rugged the Old West really was. See how Jackson evolved from an outpost of hunting and trapping into the community that you see today.

Town Square Shootout

Witness a fantastic reenactment of the wildest cowboys in the west. Cowboys appear around the square to battle one another in clever wit and the quickest draw! It's fun! It's wild! It's free! Catch the excitement that brings locals and tourists together in the heart of Jackson. The Shootout occurs every day at 6.00PM with the exception of Sundays. We recommend arriving a few minutes early to ensure the best viewpoint possible.

Cultural Insight

Jackson Hole Center For The Arts

The Center for the Arts is home to many local arts organizations, educational activities and other community gatherings. The Center houses a state of the art Performing Arts Pavilion, which includes a 500-seat theatre and a Music Center. They offer a wide spectrum of events such as theatre productions, musical concerts, and films, as well as art talks, openings and exhibits. The Off Square Theatre Company, a vibrant theatre company, is based at the Center for the Arts.

Photography Workshops

David Brookover, the owner of Brookover Gallery located in Gaslight Alley in the Town of Jackson, hosts an intimate photography workshop throughout the summer season. Learn and study the importance of light, composition, angle of views, texture and empty space. We can offer private Adobe CS5 Photoshop lessons after a day in the field.

Jackson Hole Playhouse

The historic Jackson Hole Playhouse brings you a full evening of Western entertainment, from gun-slingin', singing waiters to fully-staged musical comedies. You can kick off your boots and enjoy true Western hospitality at Wyoming's longest running professional dinner theatre.

National Museum Of Wildlife Art

Intriguingly designed, the museum's sandstone building overlooks the National Elk Refuge and brings together more than 2,300 works of art from the early 19th century to the present. The museum features twelve exhibition galleries showcasing a permanent collection of wildlife art as well as several innovative rotating installations.

Jackson Hole Rodeo

This is Wild West family fun at its best! Cowboys travel from all over the country to compete in the Jackson Hole Rodeo. Complete with bucking broncos, bull riding and calf roping, this is a true Western event that will keep you glued to your seat.

For those brave adventurers who prefer to be up close to the action, we highly recommend the VIP Behind the Chutes Experience, where you can tour the livestock area, meet and learn about the cowboys, and watch the Rodeo from box seats directly above the chutes!
